## Notification

### Notice for Inviting Project Proposal Under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya - Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) in the State of Maharashtra -Last date to apply 10th April 2018.

Maharashtra State Rural Livelihoods Mission (MSRLM) inviting project applications for Deen Dayal Upadhyaya-Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) and Roshni programs in the State of Maharashtra. The State level guidelines pertaining to the proposals to be submitted as follows.

1. Project duration will be upto 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019 and duration of each trade should be minimum 3 months (576hrs).
2. Follow the notification 20/2017 issued by Mord.
3. Due care has to be taken while filling annual turnover and net worth in the application as per CA certified document or else application will be rejected.
4. Make the application simple, if organizations have work experience and having all relevant documents as per requirement in application then need to show work experience or else don't put any work experience.
5. Targets will be given to only those agencies who have excellent track record in skill development and who are ready with infrastructure as per DDU-GKY SOP (Training center and Residential facilities) with minimum 140 capacity and should be willing submit Due Diligence and ensure to commence the training 15 days after approval of Due Diligence.
6. Based on the no of centers ready and the centers capacity (minimum 140) target will be allocated and funds will be released accordingly.
7. PIAs those will come on board with MSRLM, will get first installment as 12.5 % of the total project cost after signing MoU and will get remaining 12.5% of the total project cost after commencement of the training.
